Early voting by personal appearance will be held at 2217 Washington, Greenville, TX in the Voter Administration building. (A registered voter from any precinct in the county is eligible to vote early)

- Driver License or ID Card issued by the Texas Department of Public Safety.
- A form of ID containing a photograph (Sam's Card or Employee ID Card, Etc.).
- Birth Certificate.
- U.S. Citizenship Papers.
- Pre-Printed Checks containing the person's name issued for a

financial institution doing business in Texas.

- **Official mail addressed to the person by name from a Governmental Agency (IRS).**
- **Any two forms of ID that establish a person's identity (Social Security Card, Credit Card, Etc.).**
